The things we do in a typical Sunday church service:

When you come to our church you will be greeted by someone who will be waiting to welcome you into the building.

Singing, prayer, Bible reading and message:

We usually sing some worship songs and the words are displayed on the big screen at the front of the church.





We pray together at various points in the service, normally led by one person, but everyone joins in silently.

There is a collection box for those who would like to give - but that is your choice; there is no pressure or obligation.

The Bibles in the Church are the 'English Standard Version', but everyone is free to use whatever version they feel is best for them.





There is a Bible message by the person leading, which is usually illustrated on the big screen.

The Lord's Supper:

We usually celebrate the Lord's Supper (or Communion) on the first every Sunday each month. - but this many vary from time to time.



This part of the service is simply about remembering Jesus as he died on the cross for all who put their trust in him.

Sharing the bread and wine is for those who know Jesus Christ as their Saviour, but everyone is welcome to stay during this part of our service.

Children:

The church has facilities for children and a safe, quiet area, if needed.



Refreshments:

Following the service, we sometimes have a drink available for those who would like to stay and chat. Everyone is encouraged stay and join us.
